HOW ETHNO WORKS

Ethno is based on peer-to-peer workshops wherein participants from around the world teach each other music from their respective cultures. Musicians are asked to prepare a song or tune in advance. All teaching and learning is done by ear and participants are divided into workshop groups by section — rhythm, melody, wind, vocal, etc. Ethno artistic mentors are present before and during workshops to lend a helping hand. During an Ethno, participants attend around 12-16 workshops and learn as many tunes. It all culminates in public showcases which can be standalone concerts, or connected to a larger festival. Ethnos also make professional audio recordings and livestream their concerts.

After two successful editions in Asheville NC, Ethno USA 2023 moves to the youth and cultural hub of Greensboro, NC. The 3rd edition of Ethno USA will welcome between 30-40 musicians from around the world, and 3-5 artistic mentors, plus a crew of 5-6 persons.

Ethno USA is partnered with the North Carolina Folk Festival (NCFF) and will perform on the main stage on Friday 8 September, and again on Saturday 9 September in the evening.

Our home base will be the Haw River State Park, 1,485 acres of parkland, around 15 miles north of Greensboro. At Ethno USA 2023, besides the workshops by participants and concerts at the NC Folk Festival, there also will be workshops by guest mentors — experts in the field of history, lore and music — who will share their knowledge and wisdom with attendees. School and university visits are also foreseen, as is a community concert, as part of Ethno USA's social and community outreach.
